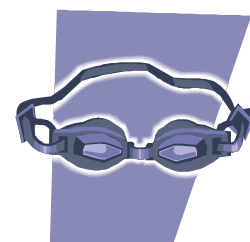

PRE COMPETITION DEVELOPMENT SQUAD UPDATE

Since the last newsletter there have been a few changes to the set-up of the Pre Competition Development squad. This is the final stage of the implementation of the ASA National Plan for Teaching Swimming (NPTS). The first stages of the plan were introduced in May 2002 with the Non Swimmer Award Level 1 Class on Saturday mornings. The success of the plan has resulted in 20 swimmers, so far, representing the Club in galas. To help identify potential gala squad swimmers in the learner pool, and monitor their progress through the width classes into the length classes, the Club have appointed Dawn Osborne as Pre Competition Development Co-Ordinator. Dawn will be assisted by Fanny Chan. The criteria Dawn and Fanny will be applying to be part of the squad is for swimmers to attend sessions regularly on Tuesdays and Thursdays, be able to swim front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke with efficient technique, with basic technique in butterfly, as well as entering the Club's Age Group Competition and Championships. If any parent needs further clarification, please see Dawn or Fanny.

In May, there will be alterations to the set-up in the length classes. Swimmers will progress from the NPTS Award Level 12, into a new Lengths 1 where they will practise for the ASA Competitive Start Award and try to achieve the

Widths 8, when they have achieved entry time for Lengths 2. Unfortunately, the changes will mean swimmers who now swim in Lengths 6 for leisure or fitness will have to swim at 9:00pm on Tuesdays or Thursdays, or on Saturday mornings. Alternatively coaching sessions are available at the Aquarena, as are life saving sessions.

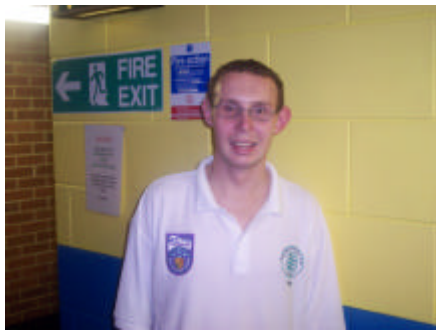

ST BARNABAS HOSPICE

The Club will be donating approximately £1,000 to St Barnabas Hospice to part fund the cost of new curtains for their day room. The amount will be made up of money raised by the Smarties Challenge, the fund held by the Club in memory of Arthur Barnett, who was patron of the Club from 1984 until his death in 1999, and Club funds.

Arthur or Barney as he was known, became the Club's first Director of Training, a position he held for 38 years, until he retired in 1989. During the early 1950's Barney was one of the Club coaches responsible for the success of Angela Barnwell in being selected to represent Great Britain for the Olympics at Helsinki in 1952, at which she finished 8th in the final of the Women's 100m Freestyle.

Barney was also President of the Club in 1970 and 1971 and again between 1981 - 83.

A former Headteacher and Vice Chairman of West Sussex County Council, Barney played a significant part in the post war success of the Club. His wise council and depth of experience was of great value to all who knew him. His memory is always remembered at every Club AGM. Further details of the presentation will be in the next newsletter.
