Swimming

Having been promoted to Division 1 of the Sussex League in 2009, staying in the league was always going to prove a tricky challenge, with teams such as Crawley and Atlantis in such strong form. After 3 battling performances, Worthing finished 7th and will compete in Division 2 next year.

It was a similar situation in the Rother League, where Worthing swam in Division 1. With just 6 teams in the league, Worthing again put in some battling performances but couldn't avoid finishing 6th and will compete in Division 2 next year.

In contrast, in the National League, Worthing are competing in Division 2 and after coming 2nd and 3rd in the 1st 2 galas, still have a chance of promotion in the final gala, in December.

In the under 17's, Tara Osborne won the girls event, whilst Callum Long won the boys event. In the Open, Elizabeth Fairs won in the ladies and Joe Hazeldine in the mens.

This, competition followed on from the Sussex 1m and 3m event held in July. In that event, 6 of the 8 titles were won by Worthing divers, with Callum Long winning 3 events, Elizabeth Fairs 2 and Daisy Hazeldine 1.
